LOCAL PRIORITY

Every three months, we listen to your concerns and look at recent crime statistics to shape the things we will concentrate on for the next three months. Our priority(s) for the next quarter is:

1. **THE FATAL 4** – speeding, drink driving, using mobile phones, no seatbelts.
2. **YOUTH ASB** – continue with a mixed and balanced proactive and educational approach and identify longer term sustainable solutions.
3. **RURAL CRIME** - Operation Actaeon is jointly agreed alongside Neighbourhood Policing at East Lindsey to provide a joint and enhanced approach to tackling, rather than displacing the issue.

WHAT'S BEEN HAPPENING

ASB – continued active patrols to deter antisocial behaviour and address any inappropriate behaviour.

CAR CRIME – there has been a recent spate of car crime across Lincolnshire. Two cars have been stolen from Welton and another attempt to gain access to property presumably to obtain vehicle keys. Another attempt was made in Waddingham. One vehicle has been recovered.
