

Cllr. Stephen Bunney's Report to Local Parish Councils in Market Rasen Wolds January 2023

Happy New Year!

I know that logistically I will not be able to attend all the Parish/Town meetings this month – so if I do not attend, please accept my apologies.

Lincolnshire County Council Budget. The executive have proposed the following budget for the period 2023 – 2024. The main expenditure items are:

£275m for adult care and community wellbeing

£84m for children's social care

£47m for highways

£22m for Lincolnshire Fire and Rescue

It has been a challenge to set a balanced budget whilst maintaining the services that residents rely on. Full details can be found on the following link

The proposals include three options for a rise in council tax of between 3% to 5%. The council will still need to use between £3.4m to £10.3m from its reserves to balance the budget.
